12:30 - 2:00pm Santa arrives and Family Skate

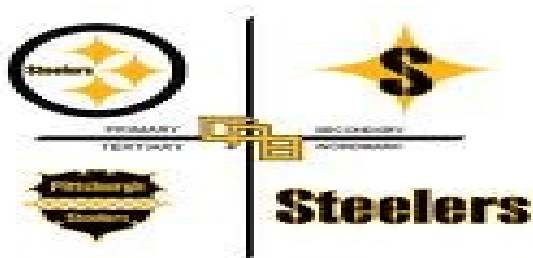


**Christmas Break:** No skating Wed. Dec. 23, Sat. Dec. 26, Wed. Dec. 30, and Sat. Jan. 2.
