REGISTRATION DATES: *NEW Fees for 2011-2012 - Increase of \$25 for Regular Lessons & Adult Synchro*

Register in person at Saltfleet Arena - Sept 8 & 14 from 6:30-8:00 p.m.

REGULAR SKATING LESSONS: Start Sat Sept 24, 2012 and end on Sat Feb 4, 2012. If your child will not be participating in Carnival, skating will end on Saturday February 4, 2012.

CARNIVAL - March 30 & 31, 2012: There is no extra fee charged for participating in Carnival. Costumes are included. Skaters are expected to attend the Carnival Rehearsal, attend any additional practices (Levels 5/6/7) & perform in both nights of Carnival.

E-MAIL ADDRESS: This is mandatory as the Club has embarked on a green initiative to help reduce paper & printing expenses.

DISCOUNT ON 2 OR MORE SKATERS PER HOUSEHOLD: *New for 2011-2012*

For households that have 2 or more skaters participating at the club, receive a \$10 discount off Regular Skating fees.

RECOVERABLE FUNDRAISING FEE: *NEW Fee Structure for 2011-2012*

This is mandatory for all skaters registered for regular lessons. The full fee can be completely recovered by selling the book of draw tickets. The initial fee is \$75 for 1 skater in the household, for a 2nd skater in the same household an additional \$25 is added to the fee, & if there are 3+ skaters in the same household another \$25 dollars is added to the fee - the maximum fee is \$125. Compared to previous seasons where the fee for 3 skaters would be 3x\$75=\$225.

PROGRAMS OFFERED:

Level 1 – Beginner Level – learn to skate program, offering professional instruction with a skating buddy system from our team of trained Program Assistants for each level 1 skater

Level 2 – Junior Level 1 (Stroking) – building on learn to skate skills i.e. stopping, balancing, gliding and skating backwards

Level 3 – Junior Level 2 (Elementary) - begin to learn forward skating edges, introduce new forward and backward skating techniques i.e. pumping and crosscuts, and turns

Level 4 – Junior Level 3 (Basic) – continue with learning skating edges, learn new complex forward and backward skating skills, spins, jumps and upward lateral movements

Level 5 - Intermediate Level 1 (Novice 1 & 2, Dance 1) – backward skating edges, continue to build on complex forward and backward skating skills, jumps and spins and basic forward ice dance skills

Level 6 - Intermediate Level 2 (Speed & Jump, Freestyle 1, Dance 2) - strengthen and enhance complex forward and backward skating skills with turns and stops, jumps and spins and basic backward ice dance skills

Level 7 - Senior Level (Freestyle 2 and Dance 3) learn more complex jumping and spinning skills, continue to strengthen forward and backward skating skills, begin to learn preliminary ice dances.

Enhanced Program -more one on one time with our skating professionals to work on complex movements, spins and jumps. Gives the skater the opportunity to have an individual choreographed skating program to a music selection of their choice. An annual enhanced skating competition is held to show off the skaters new skills and skating programs. *Note: Skaters must be registered for regular lessons. Limited spaces are available*

Synchronized Skating - is a large and fast-growing discipline, consists of 8-20 skaters on ice at one time moving as one flowing unit. This discipline of figure skating was originally called precision skating in North America because of the emphasis on maintaining precise formations and timing of the group. For a synchronized team to flow in unison, individual skaters must be competent at a variety of skating skills, including speed, footwork and ice presence. The team performs a program set to music, with required formations including circles, lines, blocks, wheels, and intersections.

Novice Synchronization Team – Begin to learn basic synchronized skating skills must be in Level 3 or 4.

Junior Synchronization Team – Level 4 to Level 6 skating levels

Senior Synchronization Team – Level 5 to Level 7 skating levels

Adult Synchronization Team – must be 16 years of age and over and preferably has skating level 7 or higher or has participated in synchronized skating programs
